






















e a new exhibit coming to help childics; 'cs! Check it out!' WHAT'S NEXT FOR

We have a new exhibit coming to help children get some early experience with the trades called Mid-Michigan Mechanics! Check it out below.

Mid-Michigan Mi

Features include:

- A kid-sized car on a lift and a photographic mural of a real service center to set the scene.
- Tool chest, pretend wrenches and lug nuts, mufflers to replace (and a creeper to take you under the chassis), containers for oil, washer fluid and coolant, tires to change and a pneumatic drill with realistic sound effects!
- A diagnostic activity with sensors lets visitors check under the hood to see if the alternator, starter or spark plugs are the problem.
- A Service Desk and computer, complete with work orders and a realistic parts inventory activity, make it a busy workplace every day.
